Colorado River Series Spearfishing Tournament

GENERAL RULES

VIOLATION OF ANY RULE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION OF ANY TEAM

- All Arizona & Nevada boating, fishing, spear fishing, skin & scuba regulations must be met and obeyed at all times. Proper fishing licenses, stamps or other are required and are the obligation and responsibility of each entrant to make sure that they are legal, so as to abide by all local, State and Federal laws.
- Spearing is allowed only in legal & designated areas as specified by law, except for dedicated launch ramps, swim beaches and areas designated as populated swim/launch areas. Any area as such, the contestant/spearo must maintain a distance of no less than 200 yards from any portion thereof that may constitute this type of closed areas. You cannot obstruct, block or restrict any access to boat launches, marinas or coves. IF UNSURE...DO NOT SHOOT. Local law enforcement are all too often themselves not sure of rules and regulations pertaining to spear fishing. Should you be stopped and or questioned, be courteous! Fines are expensive. NOTE: This is a carp shoot, shoot only LEGAL carp or subspecies. CARP, KOI, GOLD FISH are all allowed. Razor back/hump back are ILLEGAL.
- Stripper bass are not legal to shoot anywhere on the Colorado River within the boundaries of this tournament. However if any team wishes to travel to Cottonwood Cove, Nevada and north into the Willow Beach area to shoot strippers, they may legally and those strippers will be counted for total weight and large fish awards.
- Dive tool/knife is mandatory per each contestant. NO EXCEPTIONS. Heavy monofilament entanglements are possible.
- Standard diver down flag is required and mandatory per team staying within 100 feet of each other or vessel. Otherwise, one flag per person is required. Divers must stay within 100 feet of their flag at all times. Fines can be expensive.
- Spear guns MUST be unloaded at all times while at the Dive Shack USA premises, while in transport via any method, unloaded while out of the water or on a boat or other vessel. A LOADED SPEAR GUN VIOLATION IS AN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.
- Please be courteous to all entrants, sport fisherpersons & other users of the waterways. Be an AMBASSADOR for your sport and its future.
- 6:00 a.m. PROMPT roll call & briefing is MANDATORY. Meet at the "SHACK" 1086 Hwy 95, Bullhead City, AZ 86429 1 928 404 1527. If you are late for the briefing, you will incur a penalty of a 15 point team deduction and a 15 point individual point deduction if you declare individual intent.
- Each entrant is responsible for their own fish. You must keep your fish separated from other competitors and must present your fish promptly at 3:30 p.m. for weigh-in. Upon fish being weighed, teams will then immediately sign a weigh-in sheet agreeing to their total weight & number of fish. There will not be a 2nd weigh-in. Weigh-in disputes must immediately addressed prior to signing final weigh-in agreement. The weigh-in will be randomly done as teams arrive. Be sure that you are ready when your team name is called.
- This tournament is about FUN, LEARNING & HELPING others. There will be no disputes. Dive Shack USA has the final say. NO EXCEPTIONS. Any concerns must be addressed no less than 30 minutes prior to the awards ceremony.
- Point per fish...point per pound. Places awarded will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd in PRO & Novice. Individual overall. Largest fish. Smallest fish. Places awarded are subject to change without notice as are prizes. PRO & NOVICE will be determined by past competitions entered, placing and points earned.
- Any method of pole spear or spear gun will be allowed.
- Overall individual winner category. The winner will be determined by the total number of fish shot and the total poundage for the total points. To QUALIFY for this, the individual MUST declare intent & have their fish weighed separately.
- All contestants are personally responsible for unloading their fish as well as loading fish into the weigh-in baskets and disposing of fish in the dumpsters provided. Dive Shack USA personnel will not handle loading or disposing of fish.
- Spearos must be back at the "SHACK" at or before 3:30 P.M.. Late arrivals will be PENALIZED 2.0 points per minute until 4:00 p.m.. Then TOTAL DISQUALIFICATION of team.
- Any qualified spearo wishing to compete without a team mate may do so at the discretion of the organizer if unable to obtain a qualified team mate of comparable experience upon payment of the full entry fee.
- Each team may have helpers that may help with loading or unloading of fish and drivers whether vehicle or vessel. NOTE: DISQUALIFICATION will take place if, the helpers engage in the shooting of any fish, help to string or unstring any fish while the competitor is in the water unless directly at the surface holding onto the boat or in shallow water where the competitor is touching bottom near the shoreline.
- Additional addendums to rules, safety procedures, areas of open or closed shooting, warnings, recommendations or other may be brought up at roll call before competition starts. Rules are subject to change or modification by the organizers without prior notice. Check status often!
- Entrants agree to a photo release and understands that there is no monetary compensation and agree to have their pictures taken before, during or after the shoot and understand that they may be used by Dive Shack USA for any legal manner of advertising or publicity but, not limited to. Release & waiver form mandatory.
- Team names are mandatory. Teams that have competed before retain the rights to their team name.
- Individual competitor biography form mandatory.
- Any PRO may enter into the NOVICE class if entering with a novice who HAS never competed in ANY tournament ever. Otherwise, both must enter in the Pro class.

I have read and understand the rules as outlined above and have had any and all questions answered for me before signing this document. I am signing this of my own free will and state that I am 18 years of age or older. If not, my parent or legal guardian will sign for me.
